Medical Leave Extension

Commissioners,

Re:

I, Shaun Edgerton, Elkhart City Fire Chief, have received a request from Firefighter Mark Travis for an extension to his negotiated departmental medical leave.

Firefighter Travis has developed a condition that his physicians state renders him unable to perform the duties assigned to him as a Firefighter at this time. In accordance with the contract between the City of Elkhart and IAFF Local #338, Article 49, Section 8, Firefighter Travis is asking for an extension to his contractual medical leave.

Article 49, Section 8:

A Firefighter who suffers a non-work related illness or injury which renders them unable to perform the duties of a firefighter, shall be paid their current wages and have their current benefits maintained until the firefighter is able to return to active firefighting duty. This leave shall be extended up to a maximum of sixty(60) of the firefighter's regularly scheduled tour of duty days, commencing from the date of such illness or injury.

I, as Chief of the Fire Department, ask that you extend medical leave for Firefighter Travis until June 27, 2022. If by that date there is no release by his physicians to return to full duty, his employment status with the Elkhart Fire Department will be reviewed.

I ask that the board review and affirm the request for extension of Firefighter Travis.
