POWER RESTORATION:

- AEP / Indiana Michigan Power has restored power to all customers
- IF you are STILL WITHOUT power, it is most likely due to an issue with your home's electrical infrastructure
 - Please reach out to your insurance company or landlord to coordinate repair

REPORT DAMAGE:

- Please let us know about damage on your property via MyElkhart311 and/or 211
- Be aware of potential scams
 - Any repair professional that comes to your property will be coordinated by your insurance company or will be someone with the city
 - Please do not sign anything
 - Reach out to your insurance company or Elkhart's non-emergency number if you want to verify their identity 574.293.2175

DEBRIS REMOVAL:

- Please refer to the graphic below regarding separation of debris
 - This separation is important so potentially environmentally hazardous materials are easily identifiable
- Place it at the curb and the city will pick it up for disposal
- City Staff will begin burning tree and limb debris at the Toledo Road site on Monday, July 22. This debris will be transported by city staff and is NOT a drop off site for residents.

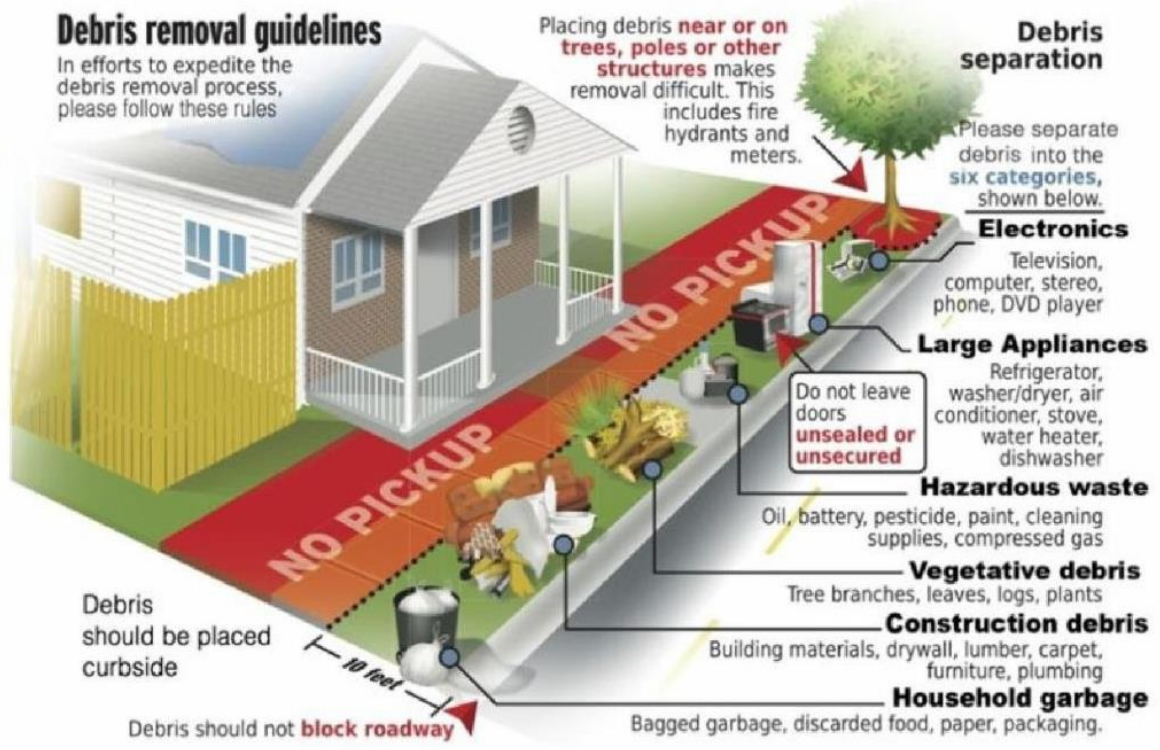

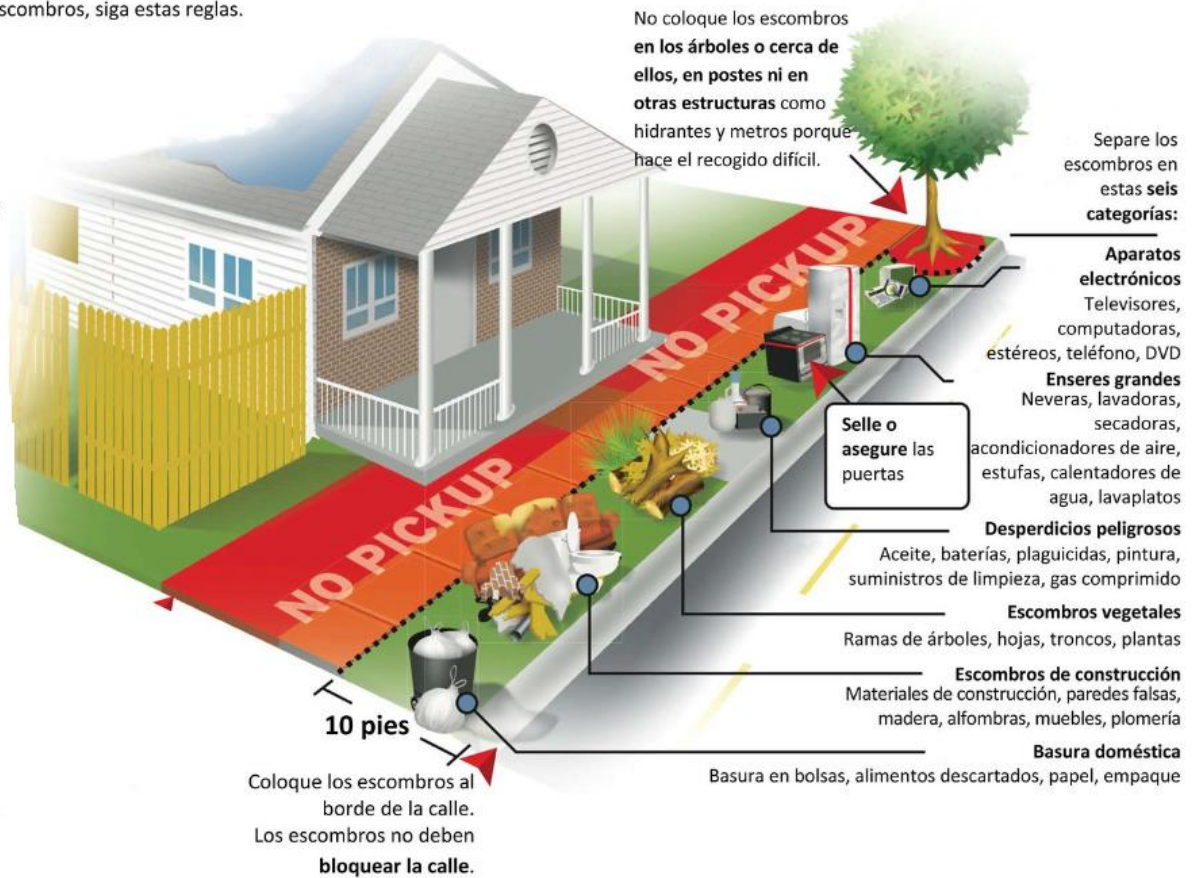
