Code Enforcement FAQs

How are codes enforced?

The enforcement process is typically initiated in several ways;

- 1. In response to a complaint by an individual.
- 2. Observation of a code violation by City Staff as they patrol the community.
- 3. As a consequence of an action.

How do I notify the City about a possible code violation?

A complaint about a possible code violation is made by letter, telephone, e-mail or in person to the Code Enforcement Officer or Office, and/or Mayors Office. Please be prepared with specific information such as:

- 1. The address of the property where the alleged violation exist.
- 2. Detailed description of the situation.
- 3. The length of time you have observed the situation.

What are some of the code enforcement violation?

Some examples of code enforcement violations are:

• Open vacant buildings, overgrown grass, weeds, trash & debris, waste, discarded furniture and appliances, and inoperable/abandoned vehicles and/or parts.
