Permitted Items

- # 2 Pencils w/ Erasers
- Current Edition of the National Electrical Code Book (NO HANDBOOKS)
- Calculator (NO PROGRAMMABLE MODELS ALLOWED)
- State Photo ID
- Scratch Paper will be furnished on request and must be returned at the conclusion of the exam.

Prohibited Items

- National Electrical Code Illustrated Handbook
- Notebooks
- Computers
- Cameras
- Any other reference material not on the permitted list above.
- Cell phones are to be left in vehicle

Violation of the above rules will cause immediate disqualification and no grade will be issued. Legal and disciplinary action will be taken against violators by the City of Elkhart Electrical Examining Board. (Ordinance 3460, City Code 157)

There will be no refunds for failing to appear.

Test dates cannot be changed after the deadline has passed.

Electrical License Information

The City of Elkhart requires that electrical work be performed by or supervised by a licensed electrician. At the present time the Electrical Examining Board is using the Prometric (formerly the Block and Associate/ Thompson Experior), Master Electrician test as a basis for granting a license.

The Board requires a minimum score of 75% to pass. The test is given locally four times a year on the second Monday of January, April, July and October. Applications must be made in person at our office, thirty (30) days prior to the exam, accompanied by a non-refundable examination fee.

Test results from other jurisdictions using the same test have also been accepted by the Board. The Board does NOT recognize licensing from other jurisdictions but, will recognize their test results. Application and fee as listed above must be complied with before the Board will accept test results. These results must be sent from the jurisdiction giving the test to the Examining Board. These results must specify who the test was given to, when it was given, the type of test and the results of the test.

The Board meets on the **fourth Monday** of each **month that a test is given**. Upon satisfying the Board as to the qualifications of the applicant, a license may be issued by the Board. A license fee and completed registration form is required before the license will be issued.
