Second St., Elkhart, Indiana. You may appear with or without counsel, you may present evidence, cross-examine opposing witnesses, and present arguments. If you fail to appear, the Hearing Officer may take action detrimental to your interests in your absence. At this hearing, the Hearing Officer may affirm the compliance agreement, or demolition order, if the property owners have not made the proper repairs to the structure, detached garage and any and all concrete slabs by the date of the hearing. If the compliance agreement or demolition order is affirmed, the City of Elkhart will demolish the building and bill the property owners for the cost of the removal of the demolition plus administrative fees.
