Checklist/Instructions for Demolitions - Residential

Please note the following information regarding demolitions:

- Demolition of any structure that is 120 sq.ft. or less does **NOT** require a demolition permit. However, a permit is required for demolition of in-ground pools of any size.
- The entire structure, including the foundation, must be demolished and removed.
- A clean-hole inspection must be done by a City Inspector prior to filling the hole.
- A licensed Demolition Contractor must obtain the permit OR

A Homeowner can obtain the permit if they are doing the work themselves.

		Copy of the Excavation Permit: first obtain an Excavation Permit from Public Works & Utilities and then submit a copy of it with the Building Permit application. A Notarized Applicant Liability & Release Form: submit a completed form with the Building Permit application. The following form must be notarized in order for it to be valid:

		<u>Proof of Disconnects for Utilities</u> (gas, water, and electric): please submit proof of disconnects for electric, gas, and water (an email from the utility company will suffice) and submit them with the Building Permit application.
