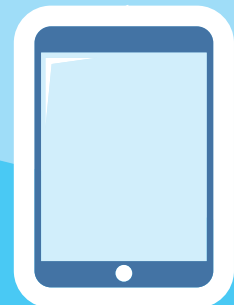
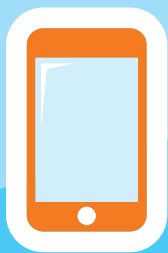

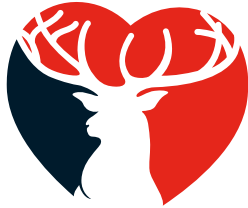

Policies and Refund Procedures

Registration and Payment Options

Registration for the City of Elkhart Parks & Recreation programs are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Unless noted, all registrations for recreation programs are only accepted at the Elkhart Parks & Recreation office.

Many originals have enrollment limits and registration deadlines. To ensure a spot in your favorite activity, please be sure to register before the registration deadline. Registering early will allow for proper staffing levels.

Programs not paid for prior to stated deadline/or first day of program will be issued a late registration fee.

Cash, Money Order or Check with I.D., or Credit Cards are accepted.



Weather Cancellation/Early Closure

NO refunds will be given, after entering any Parks & Recreation facility, for any reason.

Facilities and programs may be canceled due to inclement weather. Such cancellations, when needed, may be posted on the City's website, www.elkhartindiana.org/parks or on Facebook at Elkhart Parks & Recreation. Determination may not be made until 1/2 hour prior to opening a facility or right up to the program start time. It is advised that you call ahead prior to attending.

Early closures may include, but are not limited to, low attendance or unfavorable weather conditions such as rain, cold temperatures, or any dangerous conditions, i.e. thunderstorms, dangerous winds, etc. Power outages and mechanical problems may also require closure.



Refund Policies and Procedures

The Parks & Recreation Department has the following refund policy regarding instructional (swim/tennis) programs:

1. The Department reserves the right to cancel any activity or program due to low enrollment. If the Department cancels a program, all fees will be refunded.
2. All requests for a refund must be submitted in person at the Parks office five (5) working days prior to the first day of class. Receipt of payment is required for a refund.
3. There will be a \$5.00 processing fee per child/adult, per class, for all requests for refunds.
4. Refunds will not be given after registration has closed, except when an illness or injury (with written notice from Doctor) has occurred prior to the first day of class.

No refunds or changes/transfer after the starting date of a program for any other reason than what is listed above.

Note: Participants that register after the deadline will not be eligible for a refund.

Pets In The Park



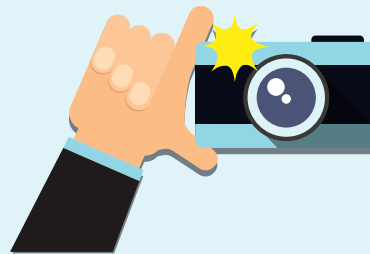
Unless specifically posted, the only pets allowed in the parks are domestic dogs, service animals and cats which are under the control of their owners at all times and secured to a leash no longer than six feet. Pet owners must clean up after and properly dispose of their animal's excrement, owners are asked to carry a device for this purpose.

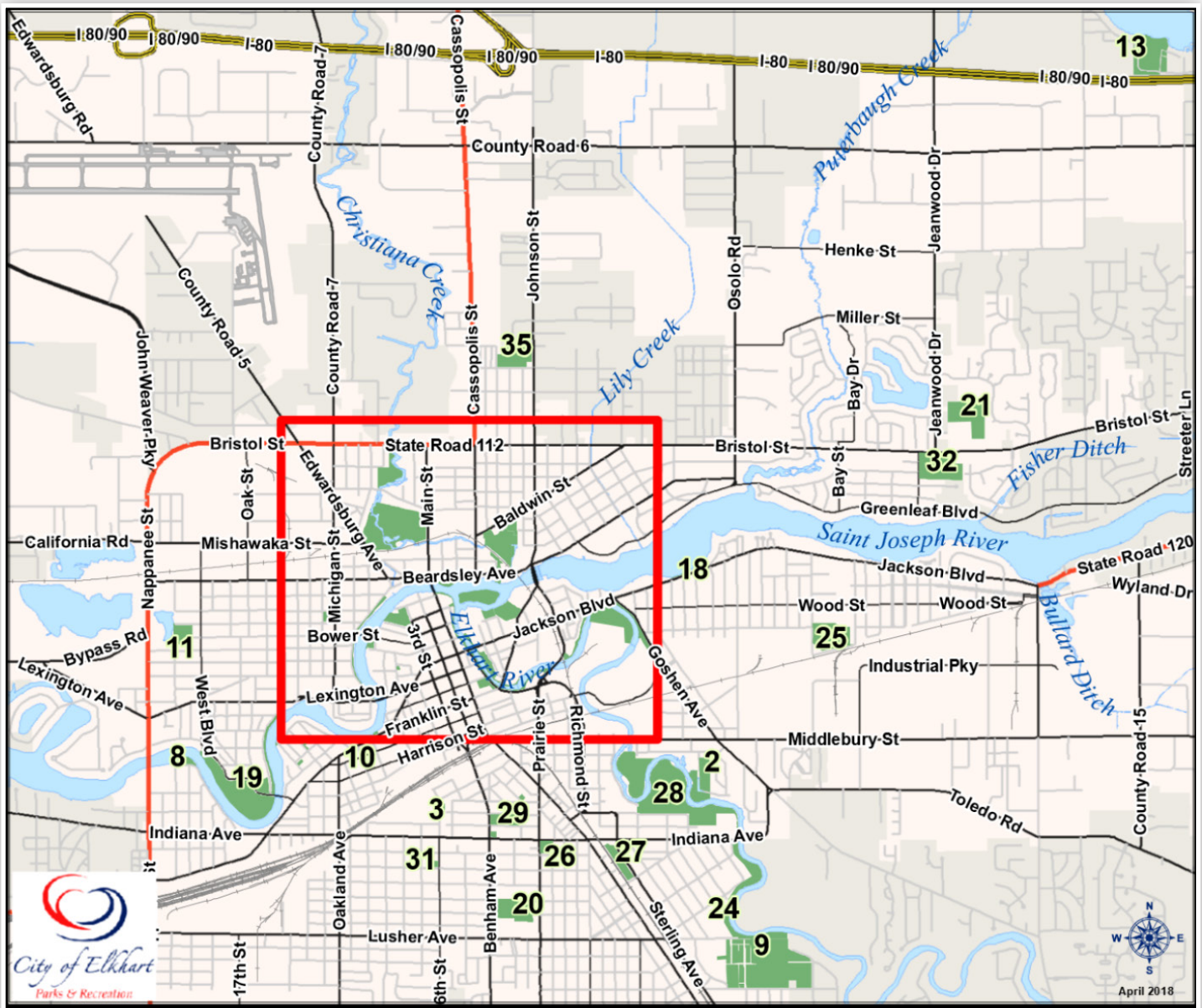

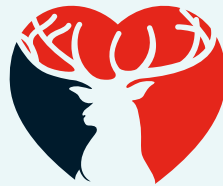
