



Electrical License Examination Information

The City of Elkhart has partnered with the International Code Conference and is pleased to offer the Masters Electrical License Examination.

Testing will be offered at City Hall, Monday through Friday, with the exception of Holidays. Testing may start between the times of 8:00am and 11:00am. The cost of the exam is \$115 and is due at the time of the exam (payment by credit card will be made directly to ICC immediately before taking the online exam). A copy of your photo ID and the electrical examination application is due to the Permit Center before the test can begin. The test is a 5 hour online proctored exam.

There will be no lunch breaks so please plan accordingly.

The exam is based on the 2017 National Electrical Code (NEC) with a 75% passing score required. The following reference materials may be used to take the exam: 2017 NEC (soft back) and the Ugly's Electrical References (any volume).

No NEC handbooks will be allowed. Writing materials are prohibited. For more information, please refer to the ICC Exam Information sheet.
