Electrical License Information

The City of Elkhart requires that electrical work be performed by or supervised by a licensed electrician. At the present time the Electrical Examining Board is using the International Code Council, Master Electrician, (2017 NEC), test as a basis for granting a license.

The Board requires a minimum score of 75% to pass. The test is given locally any week day, (excluding holidays), between the hours of 8 and 11am, by appointment only. Applications must be made **in person** at our office.

Test results from other jurisdictions using the same test have also been accepted by the Board. The Board does NOT recognize licensing from other jurisdictions but, will recognize their test results. **Application must be complied with before the Board will accept test results.** These results must be sent from the jurisdiction giving the test to the Examining Board. These results must specify who the test was given to, when it was given, the type of and results of the test as well as current license status.

The Board meets on the **fourth Monday** of each month. Upon satisfying the Board as to the qualifications of the applicant, a license may be issued by the Board. A license fee and completed registration form is required before the license will be issued.
