Electrical License Information

The City of Elkhart requires that electrical work be performed by or supervised by a licensed electrician. At the present time the Electrical Examining Board is using the International Code Council, G-16 Master Electrician Exam, (2017 NEC), as a basis for granting a license.

The Board requires a minimum score of 75% to pass. The test is given locally any week day, (excluding holidays), between the hours of 8 and 11am, by appointment only. Applications must be made in person at our office.

Test results from other jurisdictions using the same test have also been accepted by the Board. The Board does NOT recognize licensing from other jurisdictions, but will recognize their test results. The Electrical Reciprocity Application must be completed before the Board will accept test results. These results must be sent from the jurisdiction giving the test to the Examining Board. These results must specify whom the test was given to, when it was given, the type of test and the results of the test, as well as the current license status.

The Board meets quarterly to assess license applicant scores. Upon satisfying the Board as to the qualifications of the applicant, a license may be issued by the Board. A license fee and a completed Electrical License Application is required before the license will be issued.
