Below are a few tips to think about <u>before</u> you rent a property:

- Be cautious when answering online Ads. Sometimes things really are too good to be true
- Visit the property. Check for any signs of problems. Look for signs of mold, leaks, bugs, holes in walls etc.
- Ask questions. Get an understanding of things, pets, policies, cost of rent etc.
- Read through the lease thoroughly.
- Get a copy of lease and receipts. Keep these items for your records
- Take pictures before you move in.

- Pay rent on time. Keep a copy of your rental receipts.
- Follow the rules.
- Be a good neighbor.
- Know your housing rights.
