**NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED 2022 BUDGET OF
THE CITY OF ELKHART, INDIANA**

Notice is hereby given to the taxpayers of the City of Elkhart, Indiana (“City”) that the Finance Committee-of-the-Whole of the Common Council of the City will conduct a public hearing on the year 2022 budget, tax rate, and tax levy at the conclusion of the scheduled Budget Hearings on Monday, October 4th, 2021, which meeting will begin at 6:00 p.m., in the Common Council Chambers at City Hall, 229 South Second Street, Elkhart, Indiana.

Following this meeting, any ten or more taxpayers may object to a budget, tax rate, or tax levy by filing an objection petition with the Common Council of the City not more than seven days after the hearing. The objection petition must identify the provisions of the budget, tax rate, or tax levy to which taxpayers object. If a petition is filed, the Common Council of the City shall adopt with the budget a finding concerning the objections in the petition and testimony presented.

Complete details of budget estimates by fund and/or department, tax rate and tax levy are available to the public for inspection and copying at the City Controller’s Office at 229 South Second Street, Elkhart, Indiana.
