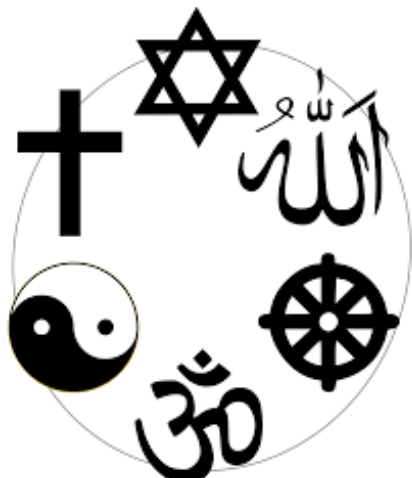

What is Religious discrimination in housing?

“Religion” includes both the practice and non-practice of religion, such as atheism, as well as religions that are outside the mainstream.

The Fair Housing Act prohibits housing providers from treating renters or homebuyers differently because of their religion or because they wear religious clothing or engage in religious practices and rituals.

If you feel that you've been denied the sale, rental or financing of a home because of religion, race, color, national origin, gender, family status, or disability. Report it to Elkhart Human Relations
