Sexual harassment by a landlord, maintenance worker, or anyone associated with your rental property is against the law. The Fair Housing Act protects you from harassment, including someone repeatedly entering your apartment without permission, making unwelcome sexual advances or refusing to make repairs because you deny sexual favors.
